

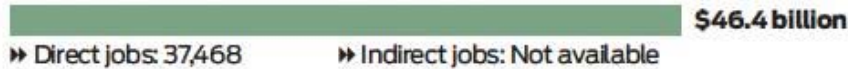
A big Army in Texas

The Army is a major player in the economies of at least five cities around the state and has grown dramatically here and in El Paso since the last base-closure round in 2005.

It's a smaller slice of the military's presence in San Antonio, where 83,162 uniformed, civilian and contractor personnel work, creating close to 190,000 jobs in the area and having a \$27.7 billion economic impact. Still, the city has been the home of Army medicine since 1947 and emerged as a center of joint enlisted medic training a decade ago.



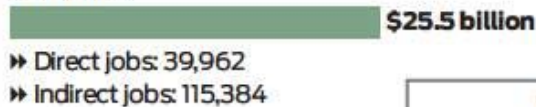
Joint Base San Antonio-Fort Sam Houston



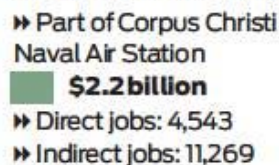
